Item #1 - Cataloging and Scholastic Books Fairs

Proposed changes below:

**A.** Order books catalogued from the Scholastic School Resource Catalog.

With your Scholastic Dollars: (50% of sales)

Basic Automation Kit costs \$2.50 per book and includes MARC record, and spine label

**B.** From the book fair books selections – look up each book you want to purchase to determine if there is already a copy in our district. If there is, purchase the book and create a copy for your school. This is copy cataloging.

Copy cataloging Requirements and Process:

- 1. If you want this option, you must attend a training, prove yourself, and then you can add copies to your collection.
- 2. To add a copy to your collection, you would request barcodes from Nancy.

Look up the book ISBN to see if it is held in our district. If no, you cannot copy catalog. If yes:

Stamp and barcode each book.

Create the copy of the MARC record for your school.

Send a list of the barcodes you added to Nancy. She will send the book labels to you.

**C.** Take 25% of your Scholastic profits in cash and purchase items from an approved vendor.
